<b>Who is entitled to register</b>	Associations which are PBWF members and associations which represent countries whose badminton associations are non-disabled members of the BWF. The rules for the registrations by German clubs will be determined in the agreed addition from the badminton department.
<b>Who can play</b>	The requirement for taking part is the presentation of a valid PBWF classification or tasking part in the organiser's classification.
<b>Deadline</b>	The registration is to be received in the post by <b>1 May 2011</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The double / mixed partner has to be named at the same time.</li><li>• Deregistration is to be made to Petra Opitz in writing.</li><li>• A fine of 50.00 EUR is to be paid to the PBWF should the deregistration not be made by 14 days before the official tournament start and the player not show up. The PBWF can also ban the player.</li></ul>
<b>Cost</b>	80.00 EUR per player, trainer, team manager and physiotherapist and 60.00 EUR for each accompanying person. The fee is to be paid together with the registration and will <b>not</b> be repaid should the player not show up.
