Organisation contribution; transport, packed lunches

Packed lunches will be distributed in the sports hall everyday from 7th to 10th June. Special wishes (vegetarian etc.) will be taken into account as far as possible. The organiser will provide a sufficient amount of still mineral water free of charge. Food and beverages will also be offered in the sports hall (not free of charge!).

Umpires: The Umpires will be named in agreement with the BWF. We are able to offer a maximum of four international umpires accommodation, daily allowances and local transport. These have to be registered with the team.

Doping: Doping is prohibited in accordance with BWF regulations! The BWF anti-doping regulations have validity. The anti-doping regulations are deemed to be recognized when registering.

Insurance: Each of the teams is responsible for insuring its members against accidents, property loss and liability claims.

Airport shuttle service: A shuttle service is offered from Düsseldorf Airport (DUS), Dortmund Airport and Dortmund main railway station to the official hotels. Participants that use a different hotel are unable to use the shuttle service.

Sports hall shuttle service: A return shuttle service from the official hotels will also be organized. Participants that use a different hotel are unable to use the shuttle service.
